

Minutes of the February 11, 2008 Kittredge Civic Association Meeting

Paul reported that he recently heard that the Flaming River Grill is no longer in business, but they plan to restart the business in the spring.

Kate Mondragon reported that she requested CDOT to sweep highway 74 through Kittredge. She made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report, which was seconded and carried by vote of those present.

Michael McGrath said that he would like to start a new artisan's association in Kittredge it will be NFS (Not For Snobs!).
